**BID FOR REMOVAL, DEWATER AND DISPOSE OF RESIDUALS**

**SCOPE**

The City of Binghamton seeks a competitive **BID** for the removal, dewatering and disposal of approximately 800 wet tons of residuals from sedimentation tanks at the Binghamton Water Filtration Plant at 25 Broome Street.

**DESCRIPTION**

The successful bidder will be asked to remove and dewater to a minimum of 20% solids so this material can be disposed of in a landfill.

**SPECIFICATIONS**

1. Removal of approximately 800 wet tons of sludge from (4) tanks.
2. Sludge to be dewatered to a minimum of 20% solid to truck to the landfill.
3. Company must supply their own equipment and trucks.
4. Company must pay all tipping fees and permits for disposal.
5. All laboratory testing will be performed by bidding company to comply with dumping permit requirements.
6. All work being done under this contract will be Prevailing Wages.
7. This work must be completed 30 days from Date of Contract.
8. The winning bidder will have the right to dewater at the City facility or haul as a liquid to their own facility.
9. The winning bidder if using a diesel pump must have a containment pad to control fuel spills 100%. No diesel may enter the water on the basin at any point.

**CITY WILL SUPPLY**

- Electric Hookups up to 480V Diesel Generator on hand to supply power
- Space to set up
- Dewatering effluent can be handled on site
- City can supply a local laboratory for testing if required.
