
WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that the City enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with Barton & Loguidice to provide field design, construction inspection, and construction management services at a cost not to exceed \$468,000; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 1, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Barton & Loguidice for the 6<sup>th</sup> Ward Sewer Interceptor Project to provide field design, construction inspection, and construction management services, at a cost not to exceed \$468,000 and that funds will be deducted from budget line H8120.525215.20817 (Southside Interceptor Project) for this purpose.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends the City enter into an agreement with Shumaker Consulting Engineering & Land Surveying, D.P.C. for professional engineering services for the Hiner Road Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the cost for such services is \$136,698.66 and funds are available for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Shumaker Consulting Engineering & Land Surveying, D.P.C., approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, for professional engineering services for the Hiner Road Improvement Project, at a cost not to exceed \$136,698.66; and be it further

RESOLVED that \$119,611.33 shall be deducted from budget line H5112.555555.E0010 (Hiner Road FEMA Improvement) and that \$17,087.33 shall be deducted from budget line H5112.525299 (Hiner Road Improvements) for this purpose.
