**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Comptroller find it proper and necessary to amend the 2018 budget for Police Department Renovations; and

WHEREAS, the budget transfer was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on November 7, 2018.



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
