AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018
DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION
TECHNOLOGY BUDGET FOR PARKING
METER FEES AND SERVICES

WHEREAS, the IT Manager and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2018 Department of Information Technology budget for parking meter fees and services; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on November 7, 2018.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2018 Department of Information Technology budget for parking meter fees and services as follows:

- (i) \$20,000 increase to revenue budget line A.41741 (Parking Meter Fees)
- (ii) \$20,000 increase to expense budget line A1680.54409 (Parking Meter Fees/Services)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediatly.
