**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 124-20,
OLD-AGE AND SURVIVORS INSURANCE
COVERAGE**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to amend the City Code Chapter 124, *Personnel Policies*, §124-20, *Old-Age and Survivors Insurance Coverage*, to delete and replace this section as provided below.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 124, *Personnel Policies*, §124-20, *Old-Age and Survivors Insurance Coverage*, is deleted and replaced as follows: "The City of Binghamton does not designate any positions to be covered by Section 218 of the Federal Social Security Act. Covered positions, if any, shall be determined by the State of New York and the Social Security Administration pursuant to a Section 218 Agreement."

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
