**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018
BUREAU OF FIRE BUDGET TO INCREASE
OVERTIME AND AMBULANCE DUTY PAY**

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2018 Bureau of Fire budget to increase overtime and ambulance duty pay; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendment was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on November 20, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2018 Bureau of Fire budget to increase overtime and ambulance duty pay as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):

\$100,000 A9015.58000 (Police & Fire Retirement)
26,500 A3410.51000 (Per Serv- Firefighter Grade 1)
15,000 A3410.51660 (AL Leave Time)

\$141,500


Transfer To (Increase):

\$139,000 A3410.51900 (Overtime)
2,500 A3410.51670 (Ambulance Duty Pay)

\$141,500

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
