AN ORDINANCE TO RECONCILE THE 2018
BUREAU OF FIRE BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to reconcile the 2018 Bureau of Fire budget to increase and decrease multiple budget lines; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendment was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on January 9, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to reconcile the 2018 Bureau of Fire budget to increase and decrease multiple budget lines as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):

6,000 A3410.52600 (Equipment)
5,000 A3410.54102 (Operating Supplies)
5,000 A3410.54190 (Uniforms)

\$51,580

Transfer To (Increase):

\$42,000 A3410.51900 (Overtime)
8,000 A3410.51600 (Holiday Pay)
1,500 A3410.51630 (Out of Title)
80 A3410.51670 (Ambulance Duty
Pay)

\$51,580

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
