**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018  
BUREAU OF POLICE BUDGET TO INCREASE  
GASOLINE/DIESEL FUEL EXPENSES FOR

WHEREAS, the Police Chief and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2018 Bureau of Police budget to increase gasoline/diesel fuel expenses for December 2018 charges; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendment was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on February 20, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:



Transfer From (Decrease):  
\$1,539.67 A3120.51016 (School Guards)

Transfer To (Increase):  
\$1,539.67 A3120.54112 (Gasoline/Diesel Fuel)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
