**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS BUDGET
TO FUND A TEMPORARY DISPATCHER
POSITION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Ordinance O18-83, dated October 3, 2018, the 2018 Department of Public Works budget was amended to add and fund a temporary dispatcher position; and

WHEREAS, there is still a vacancy in the dispatcher position and the 2019 Department of Public Works budget must be amended to provide for a temporary dispatcher position; and

WHEREAS, the budget transfer was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on February 20, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2019 Department of Public Works budget to amend budget line A1650.51000 (Per Serv) to add a "Dispatcher, Temporary."

Section 2. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2019 Department of Public Works budget to fund the "Dispatcher, Temporary" as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):


\$17,690 A5110.54130 (Construction Materials)

Transfer To (Increase):

\$17,690 A1650.51000 (Dispatch, Temp)

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect as of January 1, 2019.
