AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019  
CAPITAL BUDGET TO PURCHASE A  
SPARTAN PUMPER VEHICLE FOR THE FIRE  
DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Comptroller finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2019 Capital budget to purchase a Spartan Pumper Vehicle for the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendment was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on July 2, 2019.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2019 Capital budget to purchase a Spartan Pumper Vehicle for the Fire Department as follows:

- (i) \$459,059 decrease to revenue budget line A599 (Appropriated Fund Balance)
- (ii) \$459,059 increase to revenue budget line A9950.59000 (Transfer to Capital)
- (iii) \$459,059 increase to revenue budget line H.45031 (Interfund Transfer)
- (iv) \$459,059 increase to expense budget line H3410.550009 (Fire Equipment)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
