A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF A 2018 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible for a 2018 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Local Solicitation grant ("JAG Grant") in the amount of \$26,372 to be used to fund police officer patrols in City Parks in the summer; and

WHEREAS, the JAG Grant will require an Inter-Local Agreement with Broome County whereby the City will agree to be responsible for administration of the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the JAG Grant does not require a local match; the grant funds will be administered by the Chief of Police or his designee; and the estimated date of completion will be September 30, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to accept a 2018 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Local Solicitation grant in the amount of \$26,372 and to enter into an Inter-Local Agreement with Broome County establishing the City of Binghamton as the grant administering municipality; and be it further

RESOLVED that there is no City match for the acceptance of such funds; that the Chief of Police or his designee shall be the grant project administrator; and that the estimated date of completion will be September 30, 2021.
