A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 3 WITH MCFARLAND JOHNSON FOR THE STATE STREET PEDESTRIAN/STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PIN 9009.36 AND STATE STREET/HAWLEY STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADE, PIN 9754.08

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolutions 15-118 dated November 18, 2015, 16-27 dated January 20, 2016, 17-18 dated January 18, 2017, and R18-74 dated July 18, 2018, the City of Binghamton entered into an agreement, amended agreement and authorized two no-cost time extensions with McFarland Johnson for the State St. Pedestrian/Streetscape Improvement Project, PIN 9009.36; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution 17-19 dated January 18, 2017, the City of Binghamton entered into an agreement with McFarland Johnson for the State St./Hawley St. Traffic Signal Upgrade Project, PIN 9754.08; and

WHEREAS, the Project Manager has recommended Supplemental Agreement No. 3 with McFarland Johnson for additional engineering services for both projects and a time extension to January 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$6,379; and

WHEREAS, both projects are eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, which calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose pending reimbursement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:


RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 3, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with McFarland Johnson for additional engineering services and a time extension to January 2020 for the State St. Pedestrian/Streetscape Improvement Project, PIN 9009.36 and the State St./Hawley

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St. Traffic Signal Upgrade Project, PIN 9754.08 at a cost not to exceed \$6,379 and that funds be deducted from budget line H5110.525163.21815 (Construction of State St.) for this purpose.
