
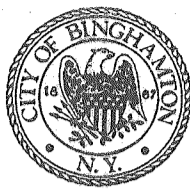


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with METRO INTERFAITH for the use of Fiscal Year 44 Community Development Block Grant funding in the total amount of \$16,000 for the Binghamton Homeownership Academy.
