
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
FIRST WARD ACTION COUNCIL FOR THE USE
OF FY 44 CDBG FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$85,000

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with FIRST WARD ACTION COUNCIL for the use of Fiscal Year 44 Community Development Block Grant funding in the total amount of \$85,000 for the operation of a Senior Home Repair Program

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with FIRST WARD ACTION COUNCIL for the use of Fiscal Year 44 Community Development Block Grant funds in the total amount of \$85,000 and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8668.533531.CDY44 (Senior Repair Program) for this purpose.
