WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with ACHIEVE for the use of Fiscal Year 40 Community Development Block Grant funding in the total amount of \$3,500 for the operation of a Summer Recreation Program for disabled students.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with ACHIEVE for the use of Fiscal Year 40 Community Development Block Grant funds in the total amount of \$3,500 and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD7310.533516.CDY40 (Youth Programming) for this purpose.
