A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NYSDOT) TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE IN THE ABSENCE OF THE GOVERNOR'S EMERGENCY DECLARATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 99-r of the General Municipal Law, municipalities are empowered and authorized to enter into municipal cooperation agreements to promote and assist the maintenance of state and municipal roads and highways; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton and the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) have reached an agreement to provide emergency assistance in the absence of the Governor's Emergency Declaration as set forth in a shared services agreement; and

WHEREAS, the term of this agreement shall be for four years until January 17, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the NYSDOT to promote and assist the maintenance of state and municipal roads and highways in the absence of the Governor's Emergency Declaration through a shared services agreement; and be it further

RESOLVED that this agreement shall be for four years until January 17, 2023.
