A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FUND GRANT PROGRAM FOR PARKS, PRESERVATION AND HERITAGE FOR THE STONE OPERA HOUSE AND STRAND THEATER HISTORIC STRUCTURE REPORTS PROJECTS AND TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE PROPERTY OWNERS FOR MATCHING FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive a \$75,000 grant from the Environmental Protection Fund Grant Program for Parks, Preservation and Heritage for the Stone Opera House (Tax Parcel 160.41-1-11) and Strand Theater (Tax Parcel 160.41-1-12) Historic Structure Reports Project located on Chenango Street; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires matching funds of \$25,000 to be paid by the property owner(s); and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation and Neighborhood Planner shall be the grant administrator and the estimated date of project completion is December of 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to accept the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to accept a grant from the Environmental Protection Fund Grant Program for Parks, Preservation and Heritage for the Stone Opera House and Strand Theater Historic Structure Reports Project located on Chenango Street in the amount of \$75,000; and be it further

RESOLVED that the matching funds of \$25,000 will be paid by the property owners and the City accepts this payment/donation; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Historic Preservation and Neighborhood Planner shall be the grant administrator and the estimated date of project completion is December of 2019.
