A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH
BROOME COUNTY FOR AN EMERGENCY
SERVICES COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM AT
ELY PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is the owner of the Ely Park Golf Course, 67 Ridge Street, Binghamton, New York (hereinafter referred to as the "Parcel"); and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to lease a portion of the aforementioned Parcel to the County of Broome as necessary for the County to construct, maintain, operate, repair, replace and remove a self-support tower and ancillary facilities to be used for providing and supporting the County's Emergency Services Communications System; and

WHEREAS, the term of this agreement shall be for a period equal to the useful life of the tower to be constructed on the Parcel and thereafter extended automatically for such additional periods of time equal to the useful life of the tower as extended by repairs, improvements and replacements of the tower by mutual written consent of the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a lease agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the County of Broome to lease a portion of the Ely Park Golf Course, 67 Ridge Street, Binghamton, New York, to construct, maintain, operate, repair, replace and remove an Emergency Services Communications System; and be it further

RESOLVED that the term of the agreement shall be for a period equal to the useful life of the tower.
