A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1 WITH BARTON & LOGUIDICE TO PROVIDE FIELD DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE 6TH WARD SEWER INTERCEPTOR PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Resolution 17-89, dated August 9, 2017, with Barton & Loguidice for the 6th Ward Sewer Interceptor Project (the "Project"); and


WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that the City enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with Barton & Loguidice to provide field design, construction inspection, and construction management services at a cost not to exceed \$468,000; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 1, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Barton & Loguidice for the 6th Ward Sewer Interceptor Project to provide field design, construction inspection, and construction management services, at a cost not to exceed \$468,000 and that funds will be deducted from budget line H8120.525215.20817 (Southside Interceptor Project) for this purpose.
