WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends the City enter into a Professional Services agreement with Barton & Loguidice, DPC for preliminary engineering and design services for the Department of Public Works Transfer Station; and


WHEREAS, the estimated cost for such services is \$19,600; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Barton & Loguidice, DPC for preliminary engineering and design services for the Department of Public Works Transfer Station, at a cost not to exceed \$19,600, and funds shall be deducted from budget line H1640.525110 (Transfer Station) for this purpose.
