A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BROOME COUNTY COUNCIL OF CHURCHES INC. (CHOW) FOR FY45 CDBG FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000 FOR THE NORTHSIDE GROCERY STORE

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with Broome County Council Of Churches Inc. (CHOW) for Fiscal Year 45 Community Development Block Grant funding in an amount not to exceed of \$150,000 for the Northside Grocery Store.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Broome County Council Of Churches Inc. (CHOW) for Fiscal Year 45 Community Development Block Grant funding in an amount not to exceed of \$150,000 for the Northside Grocery Store; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8662.533534.CDY45 (North Side Grocery Store) for this purpose.
