A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO SUPPLEMENTAL NO.1 AGREEMENT WITH BARTON AND LOGUIDICE FOR FINAL DESIGN, PERMITTING, AND BIDDING PHASE ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE MOELLER STREET STORMWATER PUMP STATION PROJECT


WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution 17-126, dated November 21, 2017, the City entered into an agreement with Barton & Loguidice to provide a feasibility and storm drainage study for the Moeller Street Stormwater Pump Station Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends the City enter into Supplemental No.1 Agreement with Barton and Loguidice for final design, permitting, and bidding phase engineering services for the Project at a cost not to exceed \$273,982.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into Supplemental No.2 Agreement approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Barton and Loguidice for final design, permitting, and bidding phase engineering services for the Moeller Street Stormwater Pump Station Project at a cost not to exceed \$273,982; and funds shall be deducted from budget line HB120.525214.20187 (Moeller St. Pump ST. Study) for this purpose.
