A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT FOR HEALTHY SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITIES **GRANT** AWARD FROM THE **BROOME** COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Resolution R23-56, dated July 26, 2023, entitled "A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to accept a Healthy Schools ana Communities Grant from the Broome County Health Department"; and

WHEREAS the amount awarded of \$20,000 is to be used to update the Complete Street Policy, develop the Complete Street Policy action plan, and complete Street projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive an additional Healthy Schools and Communities Grant from Broome County Health Department in the amount of \$10,000; and

WHEREAS, the Grant does not require a local match; the grant funds will be reimbursable, and the Grant will be administered by the Director of Planning, Housing and Community Development or his/her designee; and the estimated date of completion will be May 31, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to accept the healthy schools and communities grant from the Broome County Health Department in the amount of \$10,000 and will be available in the budget lines for this purpose as follows:

- \$10,000 increase expense budget line H8684.54410.C0045 (Pro.Ser. Planning) (i)
- \$10,000 increase revenue budget line H.42706.C0045 (Grant Other Gov.) (ii)
