AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2023 BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON CITY SEWAGE TREATMENT **FACILITIES** PERMANENT **ORDINANCE** 23-19 CORRECT VARIOUS BUDGET LINES TO DEFUND AN ACCOUNT CLERK/TYPIST AND FUND A CONFIDENTIAL SENIOR ACCOUNT CLERK POSITION

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton (the "City") is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the "BJCJSTF") with the Village of Johnson City (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF is operated and maintained by the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (the "JSB") under a series of inter-municipal agreements between the City and the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City and the Board of Trustees of the Village approve the BJCJSTF budget; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Ordinance 23-19 dated January 25, 2023 entitled "An Ordinance to amend the 2023 Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities Budget to defund an Account Clerk/Typist and fund a Confidential Senior Clerk position"; and

WHEREAS, the JSB requested an amendment to the 2023 BJCJSTF budget to defund an Account Clerk/Typist position, and to fund a Confidential Senior Account Clerk position at an annual salary of \$41,912; and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF Business Manager finds it proper and necessary to correct Permanent Ordinance 23-19 to tansfer funds from Personal Services – Hourly to Personal Services - Salaried along with related taxes and retirement in the amount of \$41,388.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Council approves and directs the Comptroller/JSB Fiscal Officer to amend and make journal budget entries in the 2023 BJCJSTF budget to correct the Permanent Ordinance 23-19 error as follows:
