AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2024 BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON CITY JOINT SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITIES BUDGET TO DEFUND MECHANICS ASSISTANT POSITION BY ONE AND INCREASE MECHANICS POSITION BY ONE

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton (the "City") is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the "BJCJSTF") with the Village of Johnson City (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF is operated and maintained by the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (the "JSB") under a series of inter-municipal agreements between the City and the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City and the Board of Trustees of the Village approve the BJCJSTF budget; and

WHEREAS, the JSB has requested an amendment to the 2024 BJCJSTF budget to defund a Mechanics Assistant position, and to fund a Mechanics position at an annual salary of \$65,852.00

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Council approves and directs the Comptroller/JSB Fiscal Officer to amend and make journal budget entries in the 2024 BJCJSTF budget to to defund a Mechanics Assistant position, and to fund a Mechanics position at an annual salary of \$65,852.00 from January 10, 2024 through December 31, 2024 as follows:
