AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2023 POLICE FUND BUDGET TO DECREASE ACCOUNTS FOR UNUSED ARPA INCENTIVE FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2023 Police Fund budget to adjust for unused incentive funds for ARPA; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on March 13, 2024.

- \$96,297.00 decrease expense budget line A3120.51000.F0015 (PRS. SVC. POLICE ARPA)
- (ii) \$96,297.00 decrease revenue budget line A.44089.F0015 (FED AID OTHER-ARPA)

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
