A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO ACCEPT A GRANT FOR \$9,000 FROM THE  
BROOME COUNTY SMALL COMMUNITY  
GRANT PROGRAM FOR HANDICAPPED  
CHAIR LIFTS

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton applied for and received a grant in the amount of  
\$9,000 through the Broome County Small Community Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the funding contributes to installing and replacing two ADA-compliant  
Handicapped Chair Lifts at the pools at Webster Street Park and Cheri Lindsey Park; and

WHEREAS, there is no required City match; that pending reimbursement, funding for the  
project shall be drawn from the general fund; that the Commissioner of Parks & Recreation will  
be the grant project manager; and that the anticipated date of project completion is Summer 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular  
session does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized  
to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation  
Counsel, to accept a grant in the amount of \$9,000 from the Broome County Small Community  
Grant Program.
