AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2024 FIRE
BUDGET TO PAY FIRE MECHANIC FROM
CSEA UNION TO FIRE UNION EFFECTIVE
1/1/2024 WITH RETROACTIVE SALARY
INCREASE

WHEREAS, the Comptroller finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2024 Fire Department budget to pay Fire Mechanic from CSEA Union position to Fire Union position; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department will transfer the funds from the existing budget lines; and

WHEREAS, the budget transfer was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on April 10, 2024.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Acting Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2024 Fire Department budget to fund the Fire Mechanic position from CSEA to Fire Union as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024
GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO ALLOW FOR
THE DEMOLITION OF A FIRE DAMAGED
PROPERTY AT 122 HENRY STREET**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2024 General Fund budget for the demolition of a fire damaged property at 122 Henry Street; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on April 10, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2024 General Fund budget for the demolition of a fire damaged property at 122 Henry Street as follows:

- (i) \$37,500 increase revenue budget line M.42680 (INS. RECOVERY)
- (ii) \$37,500 increase expense budget line M1910.54470 (DEMOLITION)

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
