A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT NEW YORK STATE RESOLUTION TO RE-OPEN SECTION 384 OF THE RETIREMENT AND SOCIAL SECURITY LAW FOR SCOTT PAVLICK

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill A.5762 and Senate Bill S.5605 have been introduced into the New York State Assembly and Senate respectively, for the authority to allow for the enrollment of a firefighter who failed to make a timely application to participate in such optional twenty-five year retirement plan; and

WHEREAS, Scott Pavlick may elect to be covered by the provisions of section 384 of the retirement and social security law, and shall be entitled to the full rights and benefits associated with coverage under such section; and

WHEREAS, The City of Binghamton submitted a Home Rule Request to the Assembly and Senate of the New York State Legislature indicating the necessity exists for the enactment of said Legislation; and

WHEREAS, New York State Assembly and Senate approved the resolution entitled "An Act to authorize the City of Binghamton to offer an optional twenty-five year retirement plan to firefighter Scott Pavlick" to allow Scott Pavlick to be covered by the provisions of section 384 of the retirement and social security law.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:
