TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF
AFFORDABLE HOUSING

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with the First Ward Action Council, Inc. for the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding (CVY45 and CVY46) not to exceed \$577,190; and

WHEREAS, the funding will support the development of affordable housing through the First Ward Action Council's proposed scatter-site project in the City of Binghamton, including renovation of blighted buildings and new construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with First Ward Action Council, Inc. for the use of CDBG funding (CVY45 and CVY46) not to exceed \$577,190 from budget lines CD8760.535006.CVY45 and CD8760.535002.CVY46.
