WHEREAS, the Applicant wishes to hold outdoor events on the following dates for the year 2024: May 10, 18, 24, 31; June 8, 14, 22, 28; July 6, 12, 20, 27; August 2, 25; September 7, 13, 21, 27; and October 5, 11, 19, 26, such events to be held at 65 Rotary Avenue; and

WHEREAS, City Council held a public hearing on May 8, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that a special variance to the City of Binghamton's noise regulations as set forth in Chapter 292 of the Code of the City of Binghamton, entitled Noise, is hereby granted to Abel's Pub for outdoor events on the following dates for the year 2024: May 10, 18, 24, 31; June 8, 14, 22, 28; July 6, 12, 20, 27; August 2, 25; September 7, 13, 21, 27; and October 5, 11, 19, 26, such events to be held at 65 Rotary Avenue, in accordance with the attached Exhibit A; and be it further

RESOLVED that notwithstanding the foregoing, the Council of the City of Binghamton may revoke this variance, after giving written notice to the Applicant and providing an opportunity for the Applicant to be heard, for any violation of the time limits or complaints for noise in excess of the anticipated noise outlined in Exhibit A.

Live music will occur in fully enclosed, outdoor space that is part of the same parcel of land as the bar establishment, located directly behind the bar. Enclosure is equipped with permanent sound system and is reinforced with brand new soundproofing technology, including soundproof tiles built into the structure to reduce noise, and additional efforts to contain sound from traveling outside of the enclosure.

Provide a description of the sound, including estimated sound levels at the source property and across any real property boundaries, along with the date(s) and time(s) during the day that the sound will be generated.

Live music on 5/3, 5/10, 5/18, 5/24, 5/31, 6/8, 6/14, 6/22, 6/28, 7/6, 7/12, 7/20, 7/27, 8/2, 8/25, 9/7, 9/13, 9/21, 9/27, 10/5, 10/11, 10/19, 10/26 from 7:00-10:00 PM, including a variety of local musicians playing music at a reasonable volume. All music will be contained in back area enclosure, with soundproofing tiles and permanent music structure to contain sound from traveling far beyond enclosure. Sound will not cause unreasonable disturbance to neighbors and will end before 10:00 PM each date.

New directional sound system will reduce amplification and ambient noise, as well as improve sound quality within the enclosure to avoid increase in volume. Sound reduction technology, including

Enclosure is equipped with permanent sound system and is reinforced with brand new soundproofing technology, including soundproof tiles built into the structure to reduce noise, and additional efforts to contain sound from traveling outside of the enclosure.
