**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
FAIRVIEW RECOVERY SERVICES**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution R22-87, dated October 19, 2022, the City of Binghamton entered into an agreement with Fairview Recovery Services for use of CVY46 funds for homeless Emergency Solutions Grants; and

WHEREAS, additional funds are necessary to reimburse Fairview Recovery Services for expenses incurred for expanding and operating Coordinated Entry for homeless and near homeless individuals during the COVID pandemic; and

WHEREAS the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with Fairview Recovery Services, Inc. to use unspent Emergency Solution Grants funding for reimbursement in an amount not to exceed \$7,399.02.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Fairview Recovery Services, Inc. for the use of unspent Emergency Solution Grants funding in an amount not to exceed \$7,399.02 for reimbursement, and that such funds shall be deducted from budget lines CG8760.535002.CVY46 (\$7,399.02).
