President Mativetsky,

I have vetoed Ordinance 24-62, An Ordinance to Amend the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 26.

State law and this newly drafted version of our code require these materials be posted within 24-hours of the meeting "to the extent practicable." The prior version of the law that was recently changed by Council required that "A digital copy of every proposed Local Law, Ordinance, or Resolution shall be available to the Mayor and City of Binghamton employees at least 24 hours prior to its inclusion as first read legislation." I support this prior language as it places a stricter burden on City government to make sure that the public, and City Hall staff and employees, are on notice of the items up for discussion by a public body.

Prior to this veto message, I reached out to get input from Council members. Part of the input I received is that there is good faith confusion as to what "the extent practicable" means legally. This deserves further discussion, as does exploring practical barriers in the posting of materials and the timeline of legislative actions.

Keeping this local strict 24-hour requirement is a good backstop against costly litigation. If City Council fails to publish its agenda and resolutions in accordance with state Open Meetings Law, it opens the City to potential litigation which could invalidate legislation. The litigation would require in-house legal resources to defend these claims or outside counsel expenses.

In sum, I don't yet understand Council's intent or have yet to hear a reasonable argument that requires this change. When dealing with matters of open government, we should err on the side of greater transparency and notice unless there is a compelling argument against it.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton (the "City") is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the "BJCJSTF") with the Village of Johnson City (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF is operated and maintained by the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (the "JSB") under a series of inter-municipal agreements between the City and the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City and the Board of Trustees of the Village approve the BJCJSTF budget; and

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2024 BJCSB budget for necessary emergency repairs at the BJCSTF; and

WHEREAS, the owners must approve a transfer through legislation; and

WHEREAS, the budget transfer was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on August 21, 2024.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to establish budget line ES8130.52022 (BAF FIBER OPTIC) in the 2024 BJCSB budget.

Section 2. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2024 BJCSB budget as follows:

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECORD OF ACTIVITIES (ROA) FOR ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, the Office of the New York State Comptroller requires that the governing body establish the Standard Work Day for reporting days worked to the New York State and Local Employee's Retirement System based on the time keeping system of the record of activities ("ROA") maintained and submitted by these members not working a standard work day to the Clerk of this body; and

WHEREAS, the New York State and Local Employee's Retirement System Regulation for Reporting Time for Elected or Appointed Officials, Section 315.4, Record of Activities, (b)(5) Completion of the Standard Work Day and Reporting Resolutions, prescribes as a Standard Day for Elected or Appointed Officials equal to no fewer than six hours nor more than eight hours for each such Elected or Appointed Office or position for the purpose of calculating days worked for those who are enrolled in the New York State and Local Employee's Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, officials who begin a new or subsequent term of office are required to complete a three-month ROA and submit it to the secretary or clerk of the governing board within 30 days of completion; and

WHEREAS, a summary of the three-month ROA submitted by the City of Binghamton officials has been summarized on New York State and Local Retirement System (NYSLRS) Standard Work Day and Report Resolution Form RS 2417-A/B.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Council of the City of Binghamton hereby approves the ROA as presented on Form RS 2417-A/B and authorizes the Clerk to post form RS 2417-A/B for at least 30 days on the City of Binghamton website, the bulletin board at the entrance of City Hall at 38 Hawley Street, Binghamton, NY, and at the entrance of the City Clerk's Office in accordance with the requirements of public notice established by the New York State and Local Retirement System.
