AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024  
GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO ALLOW FOR  
THE DEMOLITION OF FIRE DAMAGED  
PROPERTIES AT 124 AND 126 HENRY STREET

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2024 General Fund budget for the demolition of two fire damaged properties at 124 and 126 Henry Street; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on June 26, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2024 General Fund budget for the demolition of two fire damaged properties at 124 and 126 Henry Street as follows:

- (i) \$49,482.50 increase expense budget line M1910.54470 (DEMOLITION)
- (ii) \$49,482.50 increase revenue budget line M.42680 (INS. RECOVERY)

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
