AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2024 POLICE

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2024 Police Department budget to fund the pre-existing position of Senior Clerk through 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department will transfer the funds from the existing position of Program Assistant; and

WHEREAS, the budget transfer was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on July 10, 2024.


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:


