WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive \$82,188 in funding from the Broome County District Attorney's Office to hire a Discovery Officer to assist with expenses related to discovery and pretrial; and

WHEREAS, the funds do not require a local match and the funds will be administered by the Chief of Police or his designee.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to accept \$82,188 in funding from the Broome County District Attorney's Office to hire a Discovery Officer to assist with expenses related to discovery and pretrial; and be it further

RESOLVED that there is no City match for the acceptance of such funds and that the Chief of Police or his designee shall be the project administrator.
