AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2024
GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR THE
DEMOLITION OF A FIRE DAMAGED
PROPERTY AT 51 ROBINSON STREET

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2024 budget for the demolition of a fire damaged property at 51 Robinson Street; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on September 25, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2024 budget for the demolition of a fire damaged property at 51 Robinson Street as follows:

- (i) Increase expense line M1910.54470 (DEMOLITION) \$29,857.00
- (ii) Increase revenue line M.42680 (INS. RECOVERY) \$29,857.00
