A RESOLUTION GRANTING AN EASEMENT
TO NYSEG AT 183 WATER STREET

WHEREAS, New York State Electric and Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") has requested an easement to install and maintain the electric facilities at the new Water Street Parking Garage; and

WHEREAS, NYSEG has submitted a proposed easement with an attached map showing the location of the extension of its facilities, a copy of which is annexed hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documentation, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, necessary to effectuate the granting of an easement regarding 183 Water Street to NYSEG in order to install and maintain the electric facilities at the new Water Street Parking Garage as outlined in the attachment, and that all recording or other fees regarding this easement are to be paid by NYSEG.
