**AN ORDINANCE TO DISCONTINUE A
PORTION OF OVERLAND DRIVE**

WHEREAS, a portion of Overland Drive in the City of Binghamton beginning at the fire hydrant adjacent to 25 Overland Drive and ending at the intersection with Harding Avenue has been determined to be an underutilized and substandard section of a city street and impassable for emergency vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens in the City of Binghamton and of the adjacent neighborhoods that this portion of Overland Drive be discontinued; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Planning, Housing, and Community Development for the City of Binghamton has also determined that this portion of Overland Drive be discontinued;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby directed that the section of Overland Drive beginning at the fire hydrant adjacent to 25 Overland Drive and ending at the intersection with Harding Avenue be discontinued.

Section 2. That the City of Binghamton is hereby directed to pursue all approvals, consents, authorizations, purchases or sales of this real estate.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
