A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO ACCEPT THE NEW YORK STATE PARKS,  
RECREATION, AND HISTORIC

\$50,000

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton Department of Parks and Recreation is eligible to receive a New York State Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation grant in the amount of \$50,000 to fund parks and city beautification; and

WHEREAS, a local match is not required; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be administered by Acting Commissioner of Parks and Recreation Nicholas Ballard, or his designee; and

WHEREAS, the estimated date of completion is March 31, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to accept a New York State Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation grant, in the amount of \$50,000, to fund parks and city beautification.
