
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH
VARIOUS SMALL BUSINESSES FOR
DISTRIBUTION OF COVID-19 CARES ACT
FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into agreements with the various small businesses listed in the attached Schedule I for disbursement of CARES ACT COVID-19 relief funds in an amount up to the sums also listed in attached Schedule I and in a total amount not to exceed twenty thousand five hundred dollars (\$20,500).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the various small business for CARES ACT COVID-19 relief funds in an amount not to exceed a total of twenty thousand five hundred dollars (\$20,500); and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8760.535005.CVY45 (EDW-PROGRAM-BUSINESS ASST) for this purpose.
