A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS AGENCIES FOR THE USE OF FY46 CDBG AND ESG FUNDS FOR CERTAIN SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Manager, HUD Administration and Housing, recommends entering into agreements with various agencies for the use of FY46 CDBG and ESG funds for certain services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into agreements, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with various agencies for use of FY46 CDBG and ESG funds for certain services in the total amount of \$116,056.40 deducted from budget line CD8676.533515.CDY46 (Human Services) and \$156,880.66 deducted from budget line CG6142.533550.CDY46 (ESG-Program Funds) to the agencies and in the amounts set forth in the attachment annexed hereto.
