A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF LAND FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NYSDOT) IN DEVELOPMENT OF THE NEW FIRE HEADQUARTERS FACILITY AT 235 COURT STREET

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Binghamton has been advised by the New York State Department of Transportation that certain land along Chapman Street may be made available to the City of Binghamton for the purpose ingress/egress to a proposed new Binghamton Fire Department to be located at 235 Court Street, Binghamton, New York Tax Parcel No. 160.35-2-50 to the City of Binghamton; and

WHEREAS, the State of New York agrees to convey, and the City of Binghamton agrees to purchase a release of the "Restriction of Access" over a portion of the highway boundary acquired for the City of Binghamton: North Shore Arterial Highway, SH 63-27, situated in the City of Binghamton, County of Broome, State of New York and described in Schedule A (the "Property") attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:
