

ORDINANCE

entitled

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2021 BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON **CITY** SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITIES CAPITAL BUDGET TO CREATE A WWTP-ELECTRICAL **ENGINEER** POSITION. DEFUND THE COMPUTER SYSTEMS ENGINEER AND THE HEAD ELECTRICAL POSITION

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton (the "City") is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the "BJCJSTF") with the Village of Johnson City (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF is operated and maintained by the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (the "JSB") under a series of inter-municipal agreements between the City and the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City and the Board of Trustees of the Village approve the BJCJSTF budget; and

WHEREAS, the JSB has requested an amendment to the 2021 BJCJSTF budget to create a "WWTP-Electrical Engineer" position, and to defund the "Computer Systems Engineer" position and the "Head Electrician" position; and

WHEREAS, the "WWTP-Electrical Engineer" position was approved by the Civil Service Commission on March 24, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

- That the Council approves and directs the Comptroller/JSB Fiscal Officer Section 1. to amend and make journal budget entries in the 2021 BJCJSTF budget to create a "WWTP-Electrical Engineer" position, and to defund the "Computer Systems Engineer" position and the "Head Electrician" position.
- That the Council approves and directs the Comptroller/JSB Fiscal Officer Section 2. to amend and make journal budget entries in the 2021 BJCJSTF budget to fund the "WWTP-Electrical Engineer" position from April 24, 2021, to December 31, 2021, as follows:
