DISTRICT MASTER PLAN (SDMP)


WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with Whitham Planning and Design, PLLC for the development of the Stadium District Master Plan (SDMP); and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for such services is not to exceed \$90,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Whitham Planning and Design, PLLC for the development of the Stadium District Master Plan (SDMP) at a cost not to exceed \$90,000; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line H1210.555555.M0019 (Grant ESD Stadium District Project) and H1210.525901 (ESD Stadium Expense) for this purpose.
