AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2020
BUDGET TO FUND A CLEAN-UP OF 26
SEMINARY AVENUE

WHEREAS, the building located at 26 Seminary Avenue collapsed and the debris is still located on the property; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2020 budget in anticipation of recovering the costs to clean-up the debris at 26 Seminary Avenue; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendment was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on December 23, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2020 budget in anticipation of recovering the costs to clean-up the debris at 26 Seminary Avenue as follows:

- (i) \$10,000 increase to revenue budget line M.42680 (Insurance Recover)
- (ii) \$10,000 increase to expense budget line M1910.54754 (Emergency Repairs)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
