A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR

WHEREAS, the Special Traffic Options Program for Driving While Intoxicated ("STOP-DWI") Task Force Unit has provided beneficial services to the City of Binghamton by reducing alcohol-impaired driving within the City; and

WHEREAS, Permanent Resolution No. 2019-558, adopted by the Broome County Legislature on December 30, 2019, provides grant funding to the Binghamton Police STOP-DWI Overtime Patrol in the amount of up to \$17,000 for 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as necessary to accept grant funding in the amount of up to \$17,000 from Broome County for the STOP-DWI Task Force Unit for 2020.
