A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION AND AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM NEW YORK STATE HOMES AND COMMUNITY RENEWAL UNDER THE NEW YORK MAIN STREET PROGRAM FOR THE BOSCOV'S DEPARTMENT STORE FAÇADE

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible for to apply for a grant from New York State Homes and Community Renewal under the New York Main Street Program in an amount up to \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, the application proposes funding to assist with renovation of the Boscov's Department Store Façade, located at 11 Court Street in the City's downtown; and

WHEREAS, the proposed funding will contribute to ongoing community and downtown revitalization efforts; and

WHEREAS, the grant application requires that the City Council approve and endorse the submittal of the application.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to apply for and to accept grant funding from New York State Homes and Community Renewal under the New York Main Street Program in the amount up to \$500,000 for renovation of the Boscov's Department Store Façade, located at 11 Court Street in the City's downtown.
