WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into a Professional Services agreement with Labella Associates, DPC for the Hawley Street and Washington Street traffic signal update, PIN 9754.63, for construction inspection; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for such services is not to exceed \$50,900.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Labella Associates, DPC for the Hawley Street and Washington Street traffic signal update PIN 9754.63 for construction inspection, at a cost not to exceed \$50,900; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line H1650.525423.20619 (Hawley/Wash Traffic Signal) for this purpose.
