A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
METRO INTERFAITH FOR THE ZOMBIE 2.0
COMMUNITY OUTREACH AND EDUCATION
FOR FORECLOSURE PREVENTION
ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton approved Permanent Resolution 19-60, dated August 7, 2019, in which the City was awarded a second round of grant funding in the amount of \$250,000 from the Local Initiative Support Corporation ("LISC") as part of the New York State Housing Stabilization Fund, for the remediation and resale of zombie properties within the City of Binghamton; salary funding for the Vacant Property Officer and Vacant Property Inspector; Legal Assistance; and travel and training; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Planning, Housing & Community Development of the City of Binghamton recommends that the City enter into an agreement with Metro Interfaith for community outreach and education for foreclosure prevention assistance; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for such services is not to exceed \$10,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Metro Interfaith for community outreach and education for foreclosure prevention assistance at a cost not to exceed \$10,000; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line H665.54410.C0036 (Professional Services) for this purpose.
